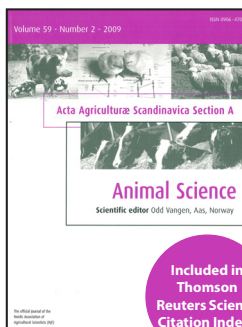

The series is published in 3 sections:



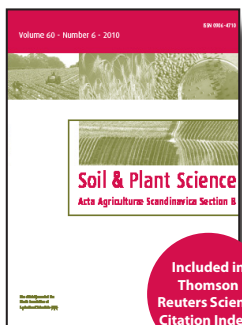
Section A – Animal Science
